

## **AUTOMATED RECYCLING VILLAGE OF LUXEMBURG**



### **PARTICIPATION IS MANDATORY AND EASY AS 1, 2, 3!**

1. Fill your automated container with only recyclables. No paint, chemicals, motor oil or other hazardous waste, construction materials, dirt, rocks, auto parts, electronics, hot ashes or coals. Recyclables do not need to be sorted and should not be bagged within the cart. To ensure collection, containers filled with recyclables may not exceed the weight limited marked on lid.
2. Close lid, grasp container handles firmly with both hands and wheel cart to the curb or point of collection on your collection day. **Your container may not be collected if placed out after 6 a.m. on your collection day.**
3. Set your automated cart at the curbside or point of collection, wheels and handle facing your home. Make sure your container are at least 5 feet from any other containers, parked cars, mailboxes, fences, trees, away from overhead wires or any other structure so that the automated collection truck can pick up your container. After collection, remove your container from the street by 6 p.m.

Garbage pickup in the Village occurs weekly on Friday, with the exception of the following dates:

All bags must be placed at the curb by 6 a.m. and must have a \$2.00 sticker placed on the bag.

## Frequently asked questions regarding recycling carts/bins:

- **What happens if my recycling cart gets broken during automated pickup?** If the recycling cart/bin is damaged during pickup, it will be replaced at no charge by Advanced Disposal. Please contact the Village of Luxemburg for replacement at (920) 845-2722. If the cart/bin is damaged by the resident or lost/stolen, the resident will be billed for a new cart.
- **Where can the cart/bin be placed if it doesn't fit in my garage?** The preference for storing the cart/bin would be inside your garage, shed or other inside structure. When not possible, please keep the cart/bin screened as best as you are able from the street and neighbors.
- **What if the cart is not big enough, can I switch out to a larger size?** Residents can request a larger cart/bin and will be responsible for the cost of changing. Pricing will be based on the cart/bin requested.
- **If I leave Luxemburg, can I take the cart with me?** NO, the cart/bin belongs to the residence/premise.
- **Can I use my recycling cart/bin for yard waste?** NO
- **What if there is not cart/bin at the house I purchased? How do I get one and who pays for it?** Any new developments will be able to get a new cart/bin at no charge. Existing homes that are vacant and no cart/bin are present upon move in, please contact the Village and we will have one delivered and the prior resident will be billed for the replacement.
- **What if I can't fit all my recycling in the cart/bin, Can I place bags/bins/boxes along the side of the cart?** All material must fit inside the cart/bin with the lids completely closed. If not, the cart/bin will be tagged and left at the residence.
- **Do I need to write my name and address on the cart?** NO
- **Where do I place the cart/bin for pickup in the winter months?** Please make sure that the cart/bin is far enough out of the snow and any obstruction to be picked up by the truck. Make sure that they are spaced (5) five feet apart and from any parked vehicles.
- **What about large non-recyclable items?** All large items can be picked up by Advanced Disposal by scheduling an appointment directly with them. The cost of the pickup will be charged directly from Advanced Disposal to the resident. Call Advanced Disposal at (920) 983-3341 or 1-800-279-1930 to arrange this service.
