- 10.05 GARBAGE AND RUBBISH. (Rep. & recr. 9-7-04, Am. 09-12-23)
  - (1) DEFINITIONS. For the purpose of this section, the terms "garbage" and "rubbish" are defined as follows:
    - (a) "Garbage" is all organic waste, refuse and residue of animals, fruit or vegetable matter that attend the use of, preparation, cooking, dealing in or storage of meat, fish, fowl, fruit, vegetable or grain.
    - (b) "Rubbish" is any waste, other than that as defined in §10.05(1)(a) and listed as Recyclable Materials in §10.14(4)(a) through (o).
  - (2) PRIVATE HAULING AND COLLECTION OF GARBAGE AND RUBBISH REGULATED. No person other than the Village and its agents, approved waste haulers, licensed contractors, or approved property owners shall collect or transport any garbage or rubbish over Village streets.
  - (3) BURNING OF GARBAGE AND RUBBISH PROHIBITED. No person other than the Village or its agents shall set fire to or burn any garbage or rubbish on any street or on any public or private premises, in accordance with Village Ordinance 12.01(3) BURNING OF GRASS AND TRASH RESTRICTED. (Am. 09-12-23)

## (4) COLLECTION BY VILLAGE.

(a) Garbage and Rubbish Collection. The Village, by its agents or licensed contractors, shall once a week collect, remove, and dispose of all garbage and rubbish from all single-family residences and multi-family residences or less. Property owners of multi-family sites greater than four residences must contract for waste collection on their own. (Am. 09-12-23)

Garbage and rubbish will only be collected from the property owner if it is placed in a waste container approved by the Village. All garbage and rubbish to be collected shall be placed in an approved waste container at the curb line no later than 5:00 a.m. of the collection day and not earlier than 4:00 p.m. the preceding day. The collection day shall be determined by the Village. Waste containers must be removed from the curb line within 24 hours of pickup. (Am. 09-12-23)

- (b) Abnormal Pick-Up. Large item collection must be arranged with the waste collection agent for an appropriate extra collection fee. (Am. 09-12-23)
  - 1. Large items, such as furniture but excluding vehicles, may be placed on the owner's property adjacent to the sidewalk but not on the terrace (the area between the right of way and curb), for a maximum of 72 continuous hours with a 30-day span; in an effort to give the item away for free prior to disposing of it. (Cr. 09-12-23).
- (c) Storage of Waste Prior to Collection. For public health and aesthetic reasons, waste shall be stored in the provided waste containers with lids prior to collection day to prevent access to rodents or other animals. Waste containers shall be stored in areas adjacent to the owner's residence. (Am. 09-12-23)
- (d) Storage of garbage and refuse in dumpsters with lids is permitted only in multifamily residential, commercial or industrial zoned areas, unless specifically authorized by the Village Board. (Am. 09-12-23)
- (e) Roll-off boxes or dumpsters are permitted in residential zoned areas only for storing construction or demolition debris during initial construction or remodeling activities. If a major construction event extends beyond a 60-day period, the contractor or landowner shall be required to obtain permission from the Village for the extended period of time needed for the use of the roll-off box or dumpster. (Am. 09-12-23)
- (f) Roll-off boxes or dumpsters that do not fit on private property may be placed on a village street for a maximum of 10 days, only with proper signage and prior approval of the Public Works Director. (Cr. 09-12-23)

## (5) METHODS OF HANDLING AND DISPOSING OF VARIOUS WASTE.
